The help CAIN provides to the neighborhood is about more than just making sure folks have a meal on the table. When CAIN creates food security for our neighbors, we help to create stability.

One Family's Story

LaTrice and her husband Lamond have three kids and own a small home together. Lamond works as a short order cook and drives for a ride share sometimes to make extra money. LaTrice is an in-home daycare provider since she stays home with one of her daughters who has a disability.

Before the pandemic, LaTrice visited CAIN pantry once a month to help them manage their budget and have a little money left over each month for emergencies. The family's income dropped dramatically during the pandemic. LaTrice shared that "CAIN has always helped us and we give back to CAIN when we can.

Things are so hard right now, I don't know what we would do if we couldn't visit the pantry each week." In addition to providing weekly pantry visits, CAIN was able to provide utility assistance.
